Course Requisite:

- Candidates for this course must be at least 16 years of age at the commencement of the course
- Candidates must be able to swim 50 meters in less than 60 seconds, be able to swim 200m on front and back continuously, treat water for 30 seconds, surface dive to deepest part of pool and pick up a manikin and enter/exit water safely
